UPDATE: Restriction on visits outside of the home and request to limit visits to homes operated by Lifetime Assistance, Inc.

Given the increase in the COVID-19 community positivity rate and to reduce the potential exposure to the people living in homes operated by Lifetime Assistance, Inc., effective Friday 12/4/2020 all visits outside of the homes will be suspended until further notice. Families may take their family member home for an extended stay.

At this time, we are also asking for your help and consideration regarding postponing on-site visits when possible. If visits are necessary, we ask that you limit your visits in duration and frequency and continue to follow previous visitor guidelines.

The health, safety and well-being of every person receiving supports from Lifetime Assistance is our highest priority. Lifetime Assistance, Inc. has been and will continue to be diligent in following health and safety protocols for the protection of the people we support and their dedicated staff.
